Mission:

The **Love Exquisite Arts and Recreation Nonprofit Center** is a 501(c)3 public charity serving North and West Philadelphia underserved communities providing gun violence intervention and prevention programs and activities, in an effort to help end senseless gun violence in Philadelphia, PA.

Programs/Activities:

In 2024, we had another successful year of sports, creative expression through the arts, digital ad financial literacy, giving back to underserved communities, which included the following programs/activities:

January 15, 2024, the Love Exquisite Arts and Recreation Nonprofit Center distributed books and violence intervention resources to over 100 people at the Martin Luther King Day of Service at Girard College in Philadelphia. Thanks to Philadelphia Book Bank for the book donations!

May 25, 2024, we held the Stop the Violence Philly Peace Walk in collaboration with Revolutionary Vision and Mill Creek Advisory Board had a successful day giving out resources and free hot dogs and hamburgers to over 75 youth and adults in West Philadelphia. Thank you to the Fox Street ShopRite for the generous hot dogs and condiment donations.

June 1, 2024, we held the Stop the Violence Philly Digital and Financial Literacy Workshop Shark Tank served over 25 underserved youth at IDAAY on Limekiln Pike in Northwest Philadelphia.

June 17, 2024, we held the Stop the Violence Philly Youth Summer Basketball Camp, a 2 week long camp in collaboration with C.O.F.A. Christian Sports, Inc. at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center in North Philadelphia, serving more than 60 underserved youth, who engaged in learning self-discipline, basketball skills and drills, as well as conflict resolution strategies.

On the same day, June 17, 2024, we also held the Stop the Violence Philly Youth Peace Olympics in collaboration with B.R.I.C. Philly, serving over 30 youth in a week long exploration of sports activities and creative expression through the arts.

June 22, 2024, we collaborated with IDAAY on Limekiln Pike's Super Saturday to bring the children Arts and Crafts Day with the focus on self-love, serving over 20 underserved youth and adults with creative expression activities that fostered self-love.

On August 19, 2024, Stop the Violence Philly Youth and Adults Empowerment Symposium took place with an All White Party style theme with a gun violence intervention and prevention focus. Over 50 underserved youth and adults engaged in dancing and fun while learning about the impact of gun violence lead by three dynamic speakers.

December 21, 2024, thanks to the generous donation of the West Philadelphia Corridor Collaborative and VestedIn, we were able to give out over 100 toys, coats, household items, toiletries, and clothing to underserved families in West Philadelphia, in collaboration with Revolutionary Vision. Thank You to All of the Volunteers and Sponsors as well! Thank you to the Fellowship Christian Church in West Philadelphia for allowing us to host the event there!

Outcomes/Impact:

Our programs focus on self-love, self-discipline, respect, conflict resolution, positive beauty culture, creative expression through the arts, entrepreneurship, financial and digital literacy, and workforce readiness. Our Programs are Open to the Public, and we served over 450 underserved youth and adults in Philadelphia, PA, who successfully completed our programs, made positive changes to behaviors in and outside of school. Some were new to our programs, as well as a lot of those who returned to engage in our programs. With more financial support, we can serve an even greater number of people. In 2024, gun violence is down by about 35%. Let's continue to be a part of the solution to ending gun violence in Philadelphia.
